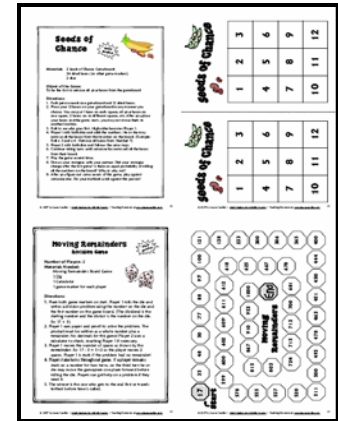


Save a Tree!

Print Multiple Pages Per Sheet

If you would like to save paper by printing your Power Packs with more than one page per sheet, try these directions. You can store the whole book of mini pages in a binder and then just print full-sized individual student pages as needed.



How to Print Multiple Pages Per Sheet

1. Open the Power Pack PDF document with Adobe Acrobat Reader.
2. Go to the **File** menu and select **Print**. (Note: Do not use the Printer Icon or the entire document will begin printing immediately. If this happens, cancel the print job.)
3. The Print dialogue box should open. Select your printer and the pages you want to print. Leave “all” selected if you want to print the entire document.
4. Look for the drop down menu next to **Page Scaling**. Click the button and choose **Multiple pages per sheet**.
5. In the **Pages per sheet** area, choose the number of pages you want to print on each sheet of paper.
6. Click **OK** to print.

Note: These steps should work on a PC with Adobe Acrobat 7.0 or higher. If the steps below don't work, try upgrading your version of Adobe Acrobat Reader. If that doesn't work, visit www.adobe.com for technical support with your software.
