Stock Market Definitions

a place where stocks and bonds are sold	a time when stock prices are falling	a time when stock prices are rising	a system in which individuals are free to own, trade, and use things in order to make a profit
money from a company's profits that is paid to the stockholders	the price a stock-broker charges to take care of buying and selling stock	to buy a variety of stocks	a legally established company
someone who lends or gives money in hopes of making a profit	the chance of losing money or assets	the group of stocks that you own	money that is made or gained as a result of an investment
shares of ownership in a company	a person who owns shares (or stock) in a company	a professional who is licensed to buy and sell stock	an exchange of goods, services, or money
