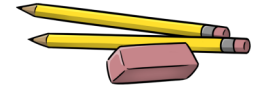

*Expressive Reading (ER) Rubric

Reads very slowly or very quickly. Does not pay attention to punctuation. Reads in a monotone voice (without any expression).	Reads a little too slowly or a little too quickly. May sound choppy, with pauses or errors. Some attention is given to punctuation.	Sounds like natural language, but has some choppiness. Usually pays attention to punctuation. Errors are self-corrected quickly and smoothly.	Reads expressively throughout most of text. Words flow smoothly and naturally, and meaning is clear.	Reads expressively and with enthusiasm throughout entire text. Reader varies expression to match meaning of text.
