Project Choices:

- Make a 3D Map of the state or region (using clay, dough, etc.) Clearly label the landforms, bodies of water, and important places.
- Put together a **cookbook** of at least 6 recipes from that region or state. Be sure to give a little information about the area in your cookbook.
- Create a presentation about that state or region using **PowerPoint** online tool or mobile device app such as Prezi, Animoto, or Glogster.
- Cook one regional **recipe** and bring samples for the class. Present the recipe, explain how you made it, and describe how this recipe is important to that region.
- Perform a **skit** of a historic event that took place in that state or region.
- Make a diorama of special attraction or historic event.
- Present a commercial advertisement encouraging tourists to visit that state or region.
- Act out a state or regional weather report. Be sure to include information about the region.
- Perform an informative rap about the state or region. Give lots of facts and information.
- Design a travel brochure showing important attractions.
- Create a travel journal/scrapbook of an imaginary trip through that state or region.
- Write a **historical fiction story** about something that could have happened there. Include historical facts in your story.
- Make an illustrated road map showing main attractions.
- Make an illustrated time line showing important events.
- Present a puppet show about the state or region.
