2. Larry visited a farm and saw five chickens and three pigs. How many legs did he count on those animals?

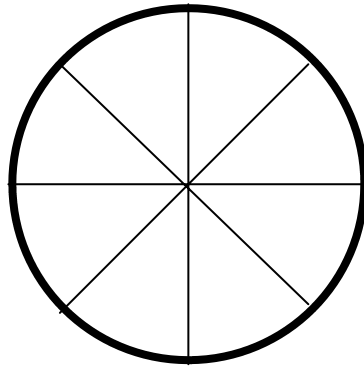
