
Go Green with Smart Sheets!


Here's a simple idea that can save money and help the environment. Instead of buying scratch pads for your cooperative learning teams, create your own scrap paper by cutting leftover worksheets into fourths. Put a small stack of scratch paper into a sandwichsized zip top bag and give one bag to each



team to store with their other materials. In our class, we call these "smart sheets" because we use them to show how we are smart!

Ways to use Smart Sheets:

- Brainstorming ideas for an activity
- Secret-ballot voting within teams or as a class
- Taking a short quiz to demonstrate math mastery
- Writing story events and placing them in sequence
- Listing book choices for Literature Circles
- Requesting a partner for pair activity
