

# Standards for Mathematical Practice

The eight Standards for Mathematical Practice should be a regular part of mathematics instruction, and they should be connected to the mathematical content at your grade level. For a more detailed description of each of the mathematical practices, refer to the Common Core Standards for your grade level. You can use the chart below as a checklist to help you determine which practices you have incorporated into your mathematics instruction each day. You don't need to use all practices every day, but you should be using them throughout the week.
