<u>Sylvester and the Magic Pebble</u> is a great book to use for St. Patrick's Day or any time of the year!"

Sylvester is a donkey who happens to find a magic pebble that grants wishes. One of Sylvester's wishes causes him to turn into a rock!



Activities:

- ◆ <u>Vocabulary Word Sort</u> ~ Use the attached word cards to have students complete a Word Sort. Sorts can be either "Open" (no established criteria set by teacher) or "Closed" (criteria established by the teacher.) Closed Sorts follow a variety of rules including number of syllables, sounds, parts of speech, etc.
- ♦ <u>Discussion Cards</u> ~ Cooperative groups place the stack of discussion cards in the middle of the team. Students take turns flipping over a card, one at a time, and discussing it.
